



- 1** Gain knowledge on Data Phishing techniques through periodic cybersecurity awareness programs or training.



- 2** Think before clicking on links in emails or text messages and verify authenticity of the information.

# 10 **WAYS** **TO AVOID** **PHISHING ATTACKS**



- 3** Install Anti-Phishing tool in web browser for quick checks on the websites and compare them with known phishing site lists.



- 4** Ensure websites' URL begin with "https" and a closed padlock icon to verify its security. Avoid downloading files from suspicious emails or websites.

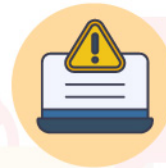
**5** Regularly, review online accounts and financial statements, and change online banking account passwords.



**6** Update web browser with latest security features. Do not ignore messages to update your browser.



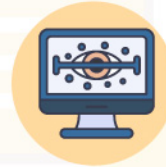
**7** Use firewall on computer and network system to block phishing threats and hackers from accessing the computer and network system.



**8** Be cautious of 'Pop-Up' windows that appear to be legitimate components of a website. Do not click the "cancel" button, which may direct you to a phishing site. Instead, click on the "x" at the window's top corner.



**9** Avoid disclosing personal or financial information online.



**10** Use antivirus software and ensure it is up to date.
